To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David

Source of melody unknown  
Harmony by Samuel Wesley (1810-1876)  
Both melody and harmony slightly adapted.

1 The LORD hear thee in the day of trouble;  
3 Re- member all thy offerings,

1 the name of the God of Jacob defend thee;  
3 and accept thy burnt sacrifice; Se lah,

2 Send thee help from the sanctuary,
